Whereas, on April 28, 2021, the Boards of both ambulance services held a joint public meeting to discuss the possible merger and answer questions;

Whereas, the ambulance boards desire to understand whether support exists, in general, among its municipal members for the concept of a merger;

Whereas, if adequate support exists for the concept of a merger, the boards of the ambulance services will continue to work on the merger and will work with their municipal members and other stakeholders on a formal plan of merger and corresponding bylaws, which would be formally voted upon and potentially ratified later in the year;

Whereas, if there is not adequate support for the concept of a merger, the ambulance boards will discontinue their merger discussions; **Now therefore,** the Town of Trade Lake Board, does hereby _____ Support or _____ Oppose, the concept of a merger between Municipal Ambulance Service (Amery Area EMS) and Northland Municipal Ambulance and desires that the boards of the ambulance services _____ continue discussions only regarding merger details or ______ discontinue merger discussions.
