

**Resolution No. 22-03**

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE  
SOURCE WATER PROTECTION PLAN  
FOR TOWN OF TRADE LAKE**

**WHEREAS**, Source Water Protection is a preventative program designed to reduce the risks to public health from exposure to contaminated water and avoid potential treatment costs; and

**WHEREAS**, Source Water Protection is achieved by managing land use in the area that contributes directly to the groundwater aquifer serving public or private water supplies;

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Trade Lake ("Town") has engaged the Wisconsin Rural Water Association to prepare a Source Water Protection Plan for the purpose of minimizing the risk of contamination of groundwater aquifer use by Town residents and public water systems for their drinking water supply; and

**WHEREAS**, the Source Water Protection Plan prepared by the Wisconsin Rural Water Association is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Town Board finds it to be in the best and vital interests of the Town and its residents to take proactive management measures to reduce the risks to public health from exposure of contaminated water.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the Town Board hereby adopts and approves the Source Water Protection Plan as prepared by the Wisconsin Rural Water Association.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under Sec. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes. Resolution takes effect the day after posting.
