## **ORDINANCE #2022-07**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF TRADE LAKE ORDINANCE #1-2005 TO REGULATE THE INSTALLATION OF DRIVEWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN OF TRADE LAKE

The Town Board of the Town of Trade Lake, Burnet County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

**WHEREAS**, On August 9, 2005, the Town of Trade Lake ("Town") in Burnett County, Wisconsin adopted Ordinance #1-2005 Ordinance to Regulate the Installation of Driveways Within the Town of Trade Lake.

WHEREAS, significate time has passed since this ordinance was adopted and the Town Board believes updating the ordinance is in the best interest of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the above Recitals, which are incorporated herein by reference, the Town Board of the Town of Trade Lake ordains as follows:

#### **Section 1 – AMENDMENT:**

- 1.1 Section V. Specifications D, shall be stricken replaced with the following:
  - D. A representative of the Trade Lake Town Board or Town of Trade Lake Road Maintenance Supervisor shall determine the dimensions of any culvert to be installed as part of the required driveway construction in order to provide proper drainage (a 'standard' culvert shall be 12" 32').

If a culvert is required the applicant shall pay actual cost of culvert plus required driveway permit fee. The Town of Trade Lake will provide one load of gravel.

Specification D. Section VI – Application/Permit Provisions; shall remain in its entirety.

#### Section 2 -- EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION:

- 2.1 This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and publication as required by law.
- 2.2 The Town Clerk shall properly publish this Ordinance as a Class 1 Notice or post this Ordinance in three locations as required under Wis. Stat. §60.80(1).
